# Nail Surgery

## What is it?

Nail surgery is as long established, safe procedure that involves the removal of a portion or the entire nail under a local anaesthetic. Depending on the type of procedure, the nail may or may not grow back again.

## Who is it suitable for?

Your podiatrist may recommend nail surgery as an option where a nail is causing pain; it is most commonly used for ingrown nails. This minor procedure is suitable for most people, special considerations must be taken if considering providing nail surgery on someone who is diabetic, debilitated, suffering with peripheral vascular disease, or on anticoagulant therapy.

## What can I expect?

Following a thorough assessment carried out by our podiatrist. The procedure itself takes approximately 1 hour.

- The procedure involves an injection of local anaesthetic into the skin at both sides of the base of the toe, this will completely numb the toe.
- The portion of/or the entire nail would be gently removed, under an anaesthetic so you are pain free throughout.
- A chemical called phenol may or may not be applied to the root of the nail so the it doesn't grow back
- Afterwards you go home, rest and elevate your leg for the rest of the day.
- You will need to return within 72 hours' post-procedure for a review appointment.

The operation site will take around 4-12 weeks to heal; and you will need to return for a further post procedure review in one month. Following the procedure, it is important to salt bath the wound, and place a new dressing on top daily until advised otherwise; to keep the wound clean and infection at bay.

Approximately <3% of nail surgery procedures carried out will have regrowth – in this case the procedure would be performed a second time.
